We will be learning:


- To notice weather changes in Winter.

- To recognise numerals and count ten and beyond.
- To compare objects by height and weight.
- To balance in different ways using different parts of the body in PE.

- To be able to write letter shapes using mnemonics.

Key Vocabulary we will be learning:

Names of different parts of the world – continent, ocean, country

Seasonal vocabulary – Winter, Spring, weather, names of different types of weather.

Language to help us to describe locations in the core story.

Parts of a whale – fin, dorsal, fluke, blowhole

Chinese New Year: the Chinese festival that celebrates the beginning of a new year on the traditional Chinese calendar.
