

We will be learning:

In Science, we will be continuing our learning on habitats, finding out about food chains. We will also be continuing to develop our knowledge of growing plants.

In Music we will be learning how to compose a piece of music. We will be learning how to make simple notations and turning single sounds into a sequence. We will be thinking about the question 'How does music represent a scene?'.

In Computing we will be learning how to programme a sprite on the app ScratchJr. We will be using the app to make a sequence of commands, use algorithms to make a specific design and debug our programs.

In R.E we will be thinking about the question 'How did the universe come to be?' hearing the Christian and Hindu creation stories.

In P.E we will be focusing on our striking and fielding skills, working with a bat and ball and focussing on hand eye co-ordination.

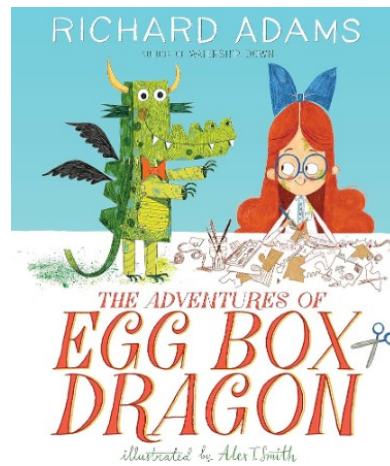
In DT we will be finding out about food and nutrition across the whole of the Summer Term.

Key English skills for your child:

- Reading and spelling the common exception words.
- Using the correct punctuation when writing.
- Writing clearly with correct letter formation.
- When reading, stopping to ask what a word means if they are unsure.
- Decoding words containing alternative pronunciation for the graphemes we have previously learnt.
- Writing a series of simple sentences which form a short narrative.

Key Maths skills for your child:

- Counting in 2s, 5s and 10s to 100.
- Knowing the value of each digit in a two-digit number.
- To recognize equal groups.
- Make equal groups to solve multiplication and division problems.
- To solve multiplication and division problems by making an array.
- To recognize and find half of a shape or number.
- To recognize and find a quarter of a shape or number.
